Dugay and to her heirs and assigns the following Chancery state, to wit: a lot of land and house which may belong to the parties of the first part at their death, but the said parties of the first part were the right of holding together of the above described tract of land, and the said Chancery state during their joint lives, and the said William Whitley conveys that he has the right to convey the said land and Chancery state to the said greater, that the said greater shall have quiet possession of the said land and Chancery state at time of his/her death, that he has done no act to encumber the said land or Chancery state and that he will execute such further instrument of the said land as may be required.
