ninety eight, between John Dennis of the County of Southampton and State of  
Virginia of the first part, and Joe Lawrence, chosen at Justice, for the first  
time named, of the other part, witnesses that the said John Dennis did  
grant, sell, convey and acknowledge unto the said Joe Lawrence Justice as aforesaid  
the following property, To wit: one grey horse, one bay horse, one doe and two  
pigs, two cattle including, all of the corn and fodder, cotton and peanuts, grown  
said or growing on all lands owned by the party of the first part in possession  
or under the management, or supervision of said party in the County of  
Southampton and State of Virginia, made in the year one thousand eight  
hundred and ninety eight. This Deed of Record is now given to James Grant  
W. Neal, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns the sum of one hundred  
and fifty six and 2/3 per. dollar, by bond dated January 17<sup>th</sup> 1795.
