

This Deed made the 3<sup>d</sup> day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven, between James M. Barrett of Surice Co. Va., of the one part, and W. H. Woods, Trustee of the other part, witnessed, that the said James M. Barrett did grant unto the said W. H. Woods, Trustee, the following property, to wit: one certain parcel or parcel of land situated in Southampton County, named as the L. S. Iron tract situated on Barrett's land, bounded as follows: on the North by L. S. Iron; on the East by Geo. S. Barrett, Trunk by A. S. Harris, and the Tract by A. H. Search. Containing fifty acres, more or less, the said as excepted by W. H. Woods, to the said Barrett of this date. But that to secure the payment of the sum of one hundred and sixty four dollars and seventy five cents, 1/10<sup>0</sup> as contained by note duly recorded in the purchase price of said land due and owing to the said James M. Barrett by Thos. H. Wood as Trustee substituted for J. C. Rice and Sons of South West & A. Jones & W. H. Stephens and the sum that default shall be made in the payment of the above mentioned land, then the Trustee, or either of them, on being required to do so by Franklin Woods aforesaid, their executors or assigns, shall sell the property hereby conveyed. And it is covenanted and agreed between the parties aforesaid, that in case of a sale, the same shall be made after first advertising the time, place and terms thereof, for six days and upon the following terms, to wit: For cash as to so much of the purchase as may be necessary to defray the expense of executing this deed, if then unpaid, and to discharge the amount of money then payable upon the said land, and of there to any deficit of said purchase money. The same shall be made payable at such time and second in such manner as the said James M. Barrett, executor, administrator or assignee shall prescribe and direct, or in case of failure to give such direction, at such time and in such manner as the said Trustee, or either of them, shall think fit. The said James M. Barrett covenants to pay all taxes, assessments, dues and charges upon the property hereby conveyed to him as he or his executors or assigns shall by law be bound.

This Deed of Bargain and Sale made the 13<sup>th</sup> day of November, one thousand eight hundred and seventy seven, between William Whiting and Margaret Whiting his wife, of the first part, and Sarah Childs of the second part, witnessed, that for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said William Whiting did bargain and convey to the said Sarah Childs and his heirs forever, with general warranty, a certain parcel or tract of land containing five acres be the more or less, adjoining the lands of Alfred T. Sargent and as a part of the same tract on which an oil
