This Deed, made this twenty sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven, between John A. Edwards of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part, and John A. Bell of the same County and State, of the other part, testifies that the said John A. Edwards, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars, with good and lawful currency, unto the said John A. Bell and his heirs and assigns, forever, the following real estate, to wit: a half or parcel of land situate, lying and being in said County, and containing by survey one hundred and sixty three and three fourths of an acre, and bounded South east by the land and daughter and others, and abutting land was conveyed to said John A. Bell and by James Dillard and wife, by deed dated the 31st day of January 1896, and to which reference is now made, and for the sum of a map of which land is the record, together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging to the same land, to the grantee, that the said grantee shall have quiet possession of said land, that he has done an act to encumber the said land, and that he will execute such further agreement of the said land as may be required.
