Rendon having on his part agreed to furnish said supplies, now the said Jas. J. Rendon on his part and in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a Sum to the said Jas. J. Rendon ten bills of actual to amount 100th each which he binds himself to deliver to Jas. J. Rendon at Lawrence Station Va, by or before the 1st day of December next of the year made in the Valley Mill Road this year when the said Ferguson now lives. For the amount advanced to him this year which has been or was intended to have been advanced, and the said Ferguson binds himself agreeable to law to deliver said bills of actual to the said Jas. J. Rendon at Lawrence Station Va, by or before the 1st day of December 1878. This Sum is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1875 entitled an act to amend the act for agricultural purposes.
