

Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton, entered at the Oct Term 1870, in the charging and trying before Honorable Pope vs Pepe, J. P. Pennell was found and declared a Convict to sell the real estate where Simon Pepe did reside, and where he did Dwell, & do all things. To S. Pepe, Hiram Pepe, and S. S. Pepe became the joint purchasers by bidding therefor the sum of Fifty Thousand Fifty Dollars, and interest. The said purchasers have fully paid all of the purchase money, and whence by virtue of the original Court or the re-sold suit, entered at the Term 1877. The said J. P. Pennell, Convict as aforesaid, was directed when the purchased money for the said land was paid to record a deed thereof to the purchasers. Now This Deed made this 15th day of Decr 1877, between J. P. Pennell, Convict aforesaid, of our part, and Wm. Daugherty, Hiram Pepe and S. S. Pepe of the other part, witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of \$1500, receipt of which I hereby acknowledge, the said J. P. Pennell, Convict at sometime did grant and convey, with special warranty, unto the said Wm. Daugherty, Hiram Pepe and S. S. Pepe, jointly, all the land in the tract or tracts mentioned herein Simon Pepe did reside, containing 170 acres, to the same more or less, and land bounded as follows, to wit: by the Road of N. Pepe, S. P. Knight, Elijah C. Peppin, Francis C. Williams, etc.

This Deed made this the 2^d day of January one thousand eight hundred
and seventy eight, between Wm. Daugherty and wife, his wife, of the
County of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part, and J. P. Pennell,
Convict for the heretofore named of the other part, witnesseth that the said
Wm. Daugherty and wife, his wife, do grant, with general warranty
unto the said J. P. Pennell, aforesaid, the following tract of land: one acre
Dwelling on the land in the town of Franklin Southampton County Virginia, aforesaid, all there
right title and interest in and to that certain parcel of land lying in the town
of Franklin Southampton County Virginia aforesaid, all there right title and interest
in and to that certain parcel of land lying in the town of Franklin Southampton
County Virginia, bounded on the North side by S. P. Knight and Franklin Street, on
the South by the S. W. R. Road, East by the S. W. R. Road and Franklin Street, West
by S. P. Knight and the lot of C. C. Daugherty, containing one acre of land
and dwelling, and situated above and east of land according to the Map of
Franklin. No house to stand late Daugherty or his heirs, executors administrators or
assigns the payment of a sum of money date January 2^d 1878 for the sum of
Six hundred dollars payable January 2^d one thousand eight hundred and seventy
eight, accruing interest at six percent from the 2^d day of January (or annum)
six hundred and seventy eight, each year of the Rent to be paid as said lot
and appurtenances according to law, and after paying all expenses including a
commission of five per cent to Justice on all rates paid by the aforesaid
and all costs due thereon, and the residue pay as the law directs
and the said Wm. Daugherty is to pay all taxes as said lot.
