Williams, his or may have, as heir at law to his deceased sister, L. L. Williams, in the same.

Corbett, one certain lot, two years old, one bay horse eight years old and one buggy and harness, to have and hold the above described property to him and his heirs forever, free and discharged of any and all encumbrances whatsoever. And for the better security of the title above conveyed I for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to and with the said James M. Corbett, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns do warrant and forever defend the same from the lawful claim of any and all persons whatever.
