Griffin the following and property, to wit: a certain parcel or tract of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southwestern State of Virginia, and bounded as follows: North, by the Transfers, road, and the land of N. C. Griffin, East by the said Suther C. Edwards and Jennifer, east by the lands of N. C. Griffin, George Lewis and Henry A. Seaman, South by the lands of said Henry A. Seaman, the Suther C. Edwards, John Seaman Jr. and Joseph H. Gray and West by the lands of Joseph A. Gray, Benjamin Coleman and John Williams, it being the tract of land on which the said Suther C. Edwards made and caused to be made, the following four hundred and fifty more or less.
