

In such a case, for the sale and separate use of the said John A. Holt and the share by her several husband, should said John A. Holt do without such share the land being assigned to said John A. Holt the first time. And the said Justice shall when required, not sending any notice to said John A. Holt, but the property being assigned, such notice of such sale in other property which shall be subject to the same laws as the property hereby conveyed.

Holt, do, and said John A. Johnson to carry on his farming operations on the lands now by George W. Borden, Southampton in consideration of the sum agreed to be advanced and the further contribution of one dollar each to the said John A. Holt, do, and the Justice of the peace of which is hereby acknowledged. And the said John A. Johnson consents and agrees that the said advance shall constitute a loan upon all the crops of every description growing and to be planted and grown on the said lands during the year of 1878. The said John A. Johnson further agrees to deliver to the said John A. Holt, do, all the land now in said lands during the year 1878, to have and to hold to the said John A. Holt, do, and the said John A. Johnson shall pay on or before the 1st day of November 1878, to pay each debt, that the said John A. Holt, do, shall after two days advertisement of those parties living in said County, will sell the property herein conveyed, in cash, and out of the proceeds pay said debt, interest and cost, and balance of such proceeds shall be distributed between J. Borden, James W. Borden and the said John A. Holt, do, for portions to their debt.
