Lawrence of the said County, all of a certain parcel or portion of land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, beginning as follows: Commencing at a small cedar standing on the east side of the South Quay and Jerusalem road, thence along the said South Quay and Jerusalem road in a northerly direction to a small sweet gum standing on the land of J. W. 2. Lawrence's land, thence in a westerly direction along the said J. W. 2. Lawrence's land to J. W. 3. C. C. land, thence along the said J. W. 3. C.
