dollars (\$4500) and debt the 5th day of March 1875. And it is agreed by the
parties to this deed that should any sale take place under this deed, it shall
be only after ten days notice and the trustee shall be entitled to 5 per cent on

Whereas, Wm. R. Gordon Esq. has advanced and
agreed to advance from time to time until Robert S. Smith and company, not
including in all, Six thousand and fifty dollars to enable the said Robert
S. Smith to carry on his farming operations on the land owned by Robert
Wrightson known as a part of the Quarter tract formerly owned by C. R.
Wrightson dead, in County of Southampton, Virginia, have therefore not
absolutely of the same advanced and further advanced to be made from
time to time and the further consideration of one dollar to the said Robert
S. Smith paid by Wm. R. Gordon Esq. the receipt of which a hereby acknow-
ledged, the said Robert S. Smith hereby covenants and agrees that the said
advances shall constitute a loan upon all the crops of every description
growing and to be planted and given by the said Robert S. Smith upon
the said land during the year of 1875. In June and 7th sold for the
following purposes to wit: if the said Robert S. Smith shall not pay to
him the 10th day of December 1875, to pay said debt, then the said Wm. R.
Gordon Esq. shall after ten days notice at such public place in said
County sell all the property herein conveyed for cash and out of the
proceeds pay said debt, interest and cost and balance of such proceeds
pay over to the said Robert S. Smith or his assignee.
