Seaton, Justice of the Peace for the County, in his former appointment in said County, and the same agreed by Wm. A. Seaton, have therefore in consideration of the same advance and further advance agreed to be made from time to time and the same consideration of one dollar to the said Joseph A. Seaton paid by Wm. A. Seaton etc., the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Joseph A. Seaton hereby covenants and agrees that the said advance shall constitute a law upon all the crops of ^{the} said Seaton growing and to be paid and granted by the said Joseph A. Seaton upon the said County during the year 1798. The said Joseph A. Seaton further agrees to deliver to Wm. A. Seaton etc., all cotton growing by him on said County during the year 1798. To have and to hold unto the following persons, to wit, if the said Joseph A. Seaton shall fail or refuse the 1st day of December 1798 to pay the said debt, then the said Wm. A. Seaton etc., shall after ten days advance of such further place in said County sell all the property herein conveyed in debt and out of the proceeds pay said debt, interest and cost and balance of such proceeds pay over to the said Joseph A. Seaton his assigns.
