Merrill & Co. merchants, of the first part, and Albert Thompson of the second, witnesses: that whereas the said Albert Thompson is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1878, from the said C. C. Merrill & Co. for the amount of seventy five dollars, and the said C. C. Merrill & Co. having agreed to furnish on instalment, and in consideration of the above advances and promises, the said Albert Thompson has hereby given a lien to the said C. C. Merrill & Co. on all the crops which may be made during the year 1878, upon the land which the said Albert Thompson does cultivate or has cultivated, by bonds for the amount of above advances. And it is further agreed by the said parties to this agreement, that the crop above referred to is to be delivered to the said C. C. Merrill & Co. on or before the 30th day of November 1878.
