+ tuting a line on the maps of the said Edwards for surveys or advances, on the day
said and together with the certificate thereto annexed, admitted to record.

This Agreement entered into this 6th day of May 1795, between Barlow and Kierulff
+ of the first part, and Suther & Edwards of the other part, whereby it is covenanted, that
+ against the said Suther & Edwards is about to engage, on the authority of the said and is
desiring to show sufficient during the year 1795, from the said Barlow and Kierulff
for the amount of forty five dollars beyond which amount the said Suther & Edwards
shall not go and the said Barlow and Kierulff having agreed on their part to
furnish said supplies, now the said Suther & Edwards, on his part, and on consideration
of the above provisions, do hereby grant a loan to the said Barlow and Kierulff, of
all the crops which may be made during the year 1795, upon the lands of which
the said Suther & Edwards are entitled for the above amount of advances which has been
or was intended to have been repaid. Now it is further more agreed by the
parties to this agreement, that the said Barlow and Kierulff shall be first paid
and satisfied after which the balance, if any, shall be paid over to the said
Suther & Edwards. This loan is granted under and out of the General Assembly of
Virginia, passed April 22nd 1795, entitled an act to secure the advances for
agricultural purposes.

James J. Jackson Henry Whitehead of the county of Southampton State of Virginia
do hereby certify that an agreement by Kierulff and Barlow of the City of Norfolk,
to the said State of Virginia, to make advances of provisions to me during the present year
for about 1795, on all of the cultivation of the crops hereafter named (said advances and
to record the same of thirty and dollars and sixty cents) and to secure the payment
of the said advances I do hereby renounce to said Kierulff and Barlow their entire
+ interest in property to wit: all my shares of cotton and corn to be raised by me, on
the following described lands, situated in now under belonging to the City of Norfolk
State during the year 1795, and also to the amounts and about above mentioned.
Teste and this special trust, that if I fail to pay said indebtedness on or before the
first day of November 1795, then the said Kierulff and Barlow may take possession
of said property, and sell same, or so much thereof as may be necessary, by and
the method for each first giving two days notice at three public places, and giving
the proceeds of such sale to the payment of said indebtedness and interest on same.
