Agreement entered into this 15th day of April 1875, between Joseph H.
Holland of the first part, and Wm. McArthur, of the other part, witnessed
that whereas the said Joseph H. Holland is about to engage in the cultivation of
cotton and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1875, from the said
Wm. McArthur, to the amount of thirty five dollars, and for taking the same
acknowledging and in accordance with the agreement and the said Wm. McArthur and
his agents and their past agreed to furnish said supplies, now the said Jos.
H. Holland on his part and in consideration of the above provisions
do hereby agree to Lien to the said Wm. McArthur and his, upon all the
crops of every description growing and to be planted and grown during the
year 1875, upon the lands owned by Jos. H. Holland. For the amount advanced
to him this year which has been or was intended to have been expended and
the said Joseph H. Holland binds himself, personally to pay to the said Wm. McArthur
the said Wm. McArthur at his place in Virginia, a sufficient quantity of said crops to
the debt by or before the first day of November 1875. This Lien is granted
under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2nd
1875, entitled an Act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes.
