Vaughan, one of the Directors of the Farmers and Merchants' Street Transportation Company (acting under the direction of the Board of Directors of said Company) of the second part, witnesseth that the party of the first part has for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty six dollars and sixty six cents the payment of which is hereby acknowledged, binds to the said C. C. Vaughan, party of the second part, for the benefit and use of the Farmers and Merchants' Street Transportation Company, the shore and wharves built and used by the Clyde Line Street Transportation Company, situated at Portsmouth Va. about one hundred yards below the drawing house of the said A. W. Norfolk for ten years from the 20th day of March A.D. 1878. The party of the first part guaranteeing a right of way to said wharf and ware house during the existence of said lease and answering for himself the right to land and store fish at said wharf and ware house.

Rice, Trustee, to have and his heirs forever the following personal property in Southampton County, Virginia, to wit: four cows, two calves, and two third yearlings, twelve sheep, and two pigs, some built and household furniture, and his entire crop of cotton, corn and wheat, which he may raise during the year 1878 on the lot he is cultivating on which Mary Griffin resides and tithes, having to secure the payment of a bond of one dollar with this deed for one hundred and fifty dollars on demand and due the said C. C. V. to the party of the first part - and it is agreed by the parties to this deed, should a sale
