Whereas, James A. Kinsred, have advanced and agree to advance from time to time unto Washington Pope an account and recording in all forty dollars to enable the said Washington Pope to carry on his farming operations on the lands owned by Ros A. Deane in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia. And therefore, in consideration of the sum advanced and further advances to be made from time to time, and the further consideration of one dollar to the said Washington Pope paid by J. A. Kinsred the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Washington Pope hereby covenants and agrees that the said advances shall constitute a lien upon all the crops of every description growing and to be planted and grown by the said Washington Pope upon the said lands from the year 1778, to hold and to hold for the following purpose, to wit: That the said Washington Pope shall, until one or before the 15th day of December 1778, to pay said debt unto the said James A. Kinsred, shall after ten days notice at three public sales in said County sell all the property, household goods, and out of the proceeds pay said debt, interest and cost, and balance of such proceeds pay over to the said Washington Pope or his assigns.
