 this day reviewed and acknowledged by the parties to be their act and deed,
 and admitted to record.

Whereas, Edward Parker of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia,
 grantor, did, by deed recorded in the Clerk's Office of the aforesaid County of
 Southampton the 16th day of April 1877, convey unto Squire C. Edwards, master
 of the said County and State, a certain ^{part} or parcel of land lying in the
 aforesaid County and State, in trust to secure the payment of a certain lot
 of ten hundred and fifty dollars, dated April 16th 1877, and due unto
 James Vaughan, said tract of land being bounded as follows, on the North
 by the lands of George Ross and Betty Calk, said land indicated by mar-
 ket or chopstick trees, East by the lands of James Vaughan and Joseph J. Norton,
 South by the lands of Joseph J. Norton, Charles Parker and Archibald Norton,
 and West by the Spring River, and containing by estimation 917 1/2 ac-
 res, or less, is being the tract of land on which the said Edward Parker
 owes, and wherein, the said land of hundred and fifty dollars due unto
 James Vaughan has been fully paid, therefore, this 25th day of
 May 1878, Edward Squire C. Edwards, trustee aforesaid, and Edward Parker
 aforesaid, witnessed that in consideration of said payment of said land,
 the said Squire C. Edwards, trustee aforesaid, did grant, release
 and remise unto the said Edward Parker, the above mentioned tract or
 parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bound-
 ed by the lands of Geo. Ross and Betty Calk and others, and contain-
 ing by estimation nine hundred, ninety and 1/2 ac-^{res}, more or less,
 with special warranty unto him, the said Edward Parker and his heirs
 forever. And the said James Vaughan indicates his consent to said grant,
 release and remise by signing and sealing this deed.
