Pope on all the crops which may be made during the year on the lands cultivated by the said David Sayer for the sum of the above advances and for the cost of this agreement. It is furthermore agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to the said J. P. Pope on or before the first day of November 1878, and that no bond of said crops is to be sold unless that be sold through the said J. P. Pope, until this agreement is satisfied.
