Smith on all the crops of every kind, raise a lien on his head cattle, and any and all horses, by him possessing the present year out, if it is agreed to the parties hereto, that the crops shall be sold for the said Rogers and after paying himself whatever may be due for the same month during the present year shall pay over the balance to said George Rogers or his heirs.
