The Deed made this 10th day of June A. D. 1878, between Harrison Chambliss of the first part and Rufus C. Rendon, Trustee, of the second part, both of Southampton County, Va., witnesses, that the said Harrison Chambliss, doth grant and convey with the said Rufus C. Rendon, Trustee, as aforesaid, the following property, to wit: Three, 3 Acres, 10 Rops, household and kitchen furniture, 1 Cart and wheels, one buggy and harness, and his entire crop of Corn, Cotton, fodder and peas, now growing on the farm known as the White House and Wesley Road, formerly belonging to R. C. Rendon, died. In Teste, however, it seems the purport of the following notes, viz: we note the Rendon and Chambliss for money, dated 1st May 1878, for payable 1st day of November 1878, with interest from that named date, one note due Rendon and Chambliss for ten hundred and twenty five dollars bearing date 1st June 1878, with interest from date, one due Harrison and Chambliss for fifty five dollars, payable 1st July 1878, with interest from that date, and one note due J. A. C. Taylor for one hundred and thirty dollars bearing date 15th July 1878, with interest from date.
