This Agreement made this 19th day of June in the year 1878, between James P. Hill of the first part, and Henry Glen of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, witnesses as follows: whereas the said Henry Glen is engaged in, or is about to engage in, the cultivation of the said land, and it is desired that James P. Hill shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the said land, which are such James P. Hill has agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesses: that the said James P. Hill does hereby promise and agree to advance and deliver to the said Henry Glen, during the present year, such money, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars in money) as may be required to enable the said Henry Glen to cultivate and gather his crops, provided to be made the present year. And the said Henry Glen does hereby give and grant to the said James P. Hill, a loan of all such crops as he may make the present year, to wit: corn, fodder, beans, peas, etc., cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the foregoing for his such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the said above said.
