This Deed made this 17th day of May one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight, between Kelling Cutshaw and Kelsey to Ketchum, his wife of the County of Side of Right and State of Virginia of the first part and W. A. Jones of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, of the second part, witnesses: that for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said Kelling Cutshaw and to Ketchum his wife, parties of the first part, of the County and State first above written, do hereby grant and convey with general warranty unto the said W. A. Jones of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, parties of the second part, all their right title and interest in and to that certain parcel or lot of lands lying and situate in the town of Franklin, Southampton Co. Va. on the South side of First Avenue, commencing on the South side of said Avenue at the North east corner of W. A. Holland's lot, thence easterly to a point on said Avenue 52 1/2 feet from said corner as aforesaid, thence Southwardly along a line parallel with F. W. Holland's and S. L. Ketchum's line to a point on the said Avenue 108 feet from First Avenue and 52 1/2 feet East of the said S. L. Ketchum's lot, thence Westwardly 52 1/2 feet to a point on the said First Avenue line 108 feet South of First Avenue, thence Northwardly along the line of the said Ketchum and Holland's lot 108 feet to First Avenue and the point of beginning, containing by estimation one eighth of an acre of land.
