ond part, witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of six hun-
dred dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Kelling
Cutchin and to be certain his wife, parties of the first part, of the County
and State first above written, do hereby grant and convey with general cov-
nants, unto the said W. A. Jones of the County of Southampton, State aforesaid,
parties of the second part, all their right, title and interest in and to
that certain parcel or lot of lands lying and situate in the town of
Franklin, Southampton Co. Va. on the South side of First Avenue, com-
mencing on the South side of said Avenue at the North west corner of P.
McKelland's lot, thence easterly to a point on said Avenue 52 1/2 feet
from McKelland's corner as aforesaid, thence Southwardly along a line per-
pendicular to said Avenue 108 feet from First Avenue and 52 1/2 feet East of the said
perpendicular line, thence Westwardly 52 1/2 feet to a point on an said lot
