This Bond of Bargain and Sale from Kelling Cutshaw wife to W. A. Sutton, and this day received and together with thereto annexed, comes to record.

Wife, M. Edwards late

Whereas John A. Cutshaw has agreed to furnish J. M. Edwards (late husband of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia) with goods to wit the said Cutshaw Store and the sum of Five hundred to the amount of one hundred dollars for the purchase of abating the said Edwards to cut down his oak, two thirds of the said oak, this 31st day of June 1878, between J. M. Edwards, of the first part and William L. Edwards of the said County, chosen as trustee of the second part, testifying that in consideration of the premises the said Edwards grants, assigns, does grant and, the said Edwards the following personal property, to wit: all of his the said Edwards oak of cotton already planted and in cultivation on the farm on which the said Edwards resides in said County of Southampton including that cut down directly by the said Edwards as well as by the said Edwards share of the oak planted or cultivated by Edwards under the said Edwards. And he further agrees to deliver the said cotton to the said trustee in Franklin as soon as the said trustee can get it picked up, provided that in the absence of any agreement or bargain to the contrary, the said Edwards shall give the market price for said cotton at the time of delivery, and the price of the sale of said cotton shall be applied to the payment of said note and the said Edwards has this day made for one hundred dollars and payable without interest this 31st day of October 1878. The said Edwards a small lot of land to said parties to secure the payment of said note.
