

Not just to further secure the amount due the creditors of the said Sheriff, but have assigned the accompanying writ forth in the aforsd writ of return referred to which is being generally and liberally made in favor of creditors of common law, when due to. And it is stipulated that the said Sheriff shall abstain from the carrying and shipping of said crops and other stuffs, the said amounts shall be subject to the control of the master to be applied to the purpose of the aforsd writ and subject to any process law that may have been created upon the aforsd crops. And it is further stipulated and agreed.

Whereas, Samuel S. Crary has advanced unto Frank Ford of Southampton County, Virginia, the sum of six dollars and seventy cents which is evidenced by a note dated 19. August 1863: and whereas, the said Samuel S. Crary agrees from time to time to make additional advances to an amount not exceeding initially fifteen dollars to enable the said Frank Ford to carry out his farming operations on the lands owned by the heirs of Niles S. Pratt dec'd. Now the right of consideration of the sum advanced and further advances agreed to be made from time to time, and the further consideration of each dollar to the said Frank Ford paid by Samuel S. Crary, the said Frank Ford hereby covenants and agrees that the said advances shall constitute a lien upon all the crops of every described growing and to be planted and grown by the said Frank Ford upon the said lands during the year 1864 (the said Frank Ford further agrees to deliver to Samuel S. Crary all the best growth on said lands during the year 1865) to have and to hold for the following purpose to wit: If the said Frank Ford shall fail or on before the 1st day of March 1865 to pay the said debt due the said Samuel S. Crary shall after 10 days advertisement at three public sales in said County, sell all the property herein conveyed for cash, and out of the proceeds pay said debt interest and cost - and balance of such proceeds pay over to the said Frank Ford or his agents.
