This we made the seventeenth day of August One thousand eight hundred and seventy eight between Amos F. Bradshaw and James H. Daughtory partners trading and doing business under the name and style of Bradshaw & Daughtory of the County of Isle of Wight State of Virginia of the first part and Am H Jenkins trustee of the County of Southampton State aforesaid of the second part witnessed that the said Bradshaw and Daughtory parties of the first part of the State and County aforesaid did grant sell and convey unto the said Am H Jenkins trustee party of the second part, two mules light over two bogys, one truck wagon, one harrowed cart, Chains, Axes & all other fixtures owned & used by them appertaining to the log business in trust to secure the payment of one certain note dated August 17th 1878, and payable on demand after date made by the said Bradshaw & Daughtory due and payable to Joel H. Leitcher for the sum of live hundred and thirty dollars and forty four cents. Also to secure one other note of twenty four dollars and twenty seven cents due & payable on demand after date to the said Joel H. Leitcher and made by the parties of the first part.
