

first part and Josiah thereof of the same County and State granted of the second part witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars to the 1st hand paid, the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged by the said Charles Parker and Jessie his wife grantors aforesaid do grant, bargain and sell with general warrantee unto the said Josiah Lross the following and premises to wit: A certain parcel or tract of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton State of Virginia and bounded as follows, by the house of Godwin Parker (now owned by Bartlett Donisthorpe) Lawrence Buoyt neip estate, Abdiel Gardner & Elisha Daran, containing by Survey One hundred and twenty acres more or less, it being the land conveyed by deed of Surveyor John Woodin Parker unto the said Charles Parker to which deed reference is hereby made for more accurate description of said land, reference is also made for the same person to survey and plot of same which is delivered along with this deed unto the said Josiah Lross, And the said Charles Parker and Jessie & his wife do declare their right to make this conveyance and bind themselves to make any further assurances necessary to convey unto the said Josiah Lross a perfect title, and to give him an undivided possession of the same together with all rights, ways and appurtenances thereto belonging.
