Clayton of the second part witnesses that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty five (\$125.00) Dollars, the said Mary A. Jordan does grant unto the said Richard M. Clayton, a Jordan does grant unto the said Richard M. Clayton, to the tract of land on which she resides and which is known as the "Key tract", containing one thousand and four hundred and seven acres more or less, bounded by Mrs. W. Battle, Jas. C. Boykin, Susan, Custow, D. S. B. Kells and the heirs of Drury Pond and reserving to Mary A. Jordan, the following condition which are hereby mutually agreed upon the said Mary A. Jordan to have full control of Division of it and such other building as may be necessary for her use, the said R. M. Clayton is to have the full and being sufficient and unable to support herself to do so at her expense during the said R. M. Clayton's life time, and it is further more agreed in case the said R. W. Clayton should die before the said Mary A. Jordan, that the said Mary A. Jordan to have a life right only, in the lands hereby conveyed, and at her death to revert back to the said R. M. Clayton or her heirs and assigns.

Jordan covenants that she has the right to convey the said land to the grantee; that she has borne no debt to encumber the said land; that the grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land, free from all encumbrances and that Mary A.
