Maury the daughter of the said F. J. Elkhorn by Lucius J. Maury her son and Emily J. Maury her daughter and by Love W. Briggs, the husband of the late Susannah - C. Elkhorn, daughter of F. J. Elkhorn, whereby each of the said parties makes her self for and in consideration of the premises and one dollar to each of them paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, undivided singularly and jointly, to grant assign & convey and by these presents do so grant, assign above and convey, all and whatever right title and interests to and in the aforesaid offices and buildings and lots - the property aforesaid mentioned, which they may have, singularly and jointly, unto the said William Elkhorn of Petersburg, Virginia - the direct situation of the makers her self living to vest in the said Wm Elkhorn the entire and complete ownership of the said property.
