be unable to pay the above mentioned Bonds or either of

spouse or assigns, shall sell the property hereby conveyed.
And it is covenanted and agreed between the parties aforesaid
that in case of a sale, the same shall be made after first ad-
vertising the time, place and terms thereof for twenty days except
to following time, to wit: For cash or to so much of the proceeds
as may be necessary to defray the expenses of executing this trust
the fee for drawing and recording this deed, if then unpaid, to
discharge the amount of money then payable upon the said Bonds
and if there be any residue of said purchase money, the same shall be
made payable at such time and manner in such manner as the
said Robert Drury and Martha Jane his wife, their executors,
administrators or assigns shall prescribe and direct or in case of
failure to give such direction at such time and in such manner
as the said Trustees shall think fit. The said Robert Drury and Mar-
tha Jane his wife, or assigns, to pay all taxes, assessments, dues and charges
upon the property hereby conveyed, so long as they or their heirs or assigns
