 potatoes. To have and to hold the said, granted, and bargained, crops, un-
 to the said le B. Crumpler and R. A. Clayton, their heirs, Executors, adminis-
 trators and assigns to their only proper use benefit and behoof for-
 ever and the said B. M. Herring does vouch himself to be the true and
 lawful owner of the good (said crops), and effects hereby sold, and to
 have in himself full power, good right and lawful authority to dispose
 of the said crops in manner as aforesaid and I do hereby give my
 heirs Executors and administrators hereby severant and agree to wa-
 rant and defend the said crops and the said le B. Crumpler and R.
 A. Clayton their heirs Executors administrators and assigns against
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

 dred, and seventy eight, between Mallory Hargrave (Grantor) of the
 one part and Robert M. Bain (Trustee) of the other part, both of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the
 said Mallory Hargrave Grantor doth grant and convey unto the
 said Robert M. Bain (Trustee) the following property to wit: One
 Horse cart + wheels, and all of his growing crop of any description
 consisting of crops of Corn, Peas, forss, so on Trust to secure a
 bond of Fifty Dollars of new date with this deed due 18th of Octo-
 ber and it is agreed that the Trustee shall have five percent commis-
 sions shewed to have to see the foregoing property. Witness the following
