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This Deed, made this 25th day of April in the year one thousand and eight hundred and forty eight between Richard H. Collings and H. F. Bradshaw of the County of Southampton Va. of the first part and William Gray of Southampton County Va of the second part, witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty Dollars the said Richard H. Collings and H. F. Bradshaw do grant unto the said William Gray with General Warrent all other certaine property or parcel of Land situate in Southampton Co. Va. and bounded as hereinafter described commencing at a dead Hickory on path, thence N 75° W 20.6 ch to pine on thence N 15° E 40.8 ch to old mill swamp (or Green on Black line) thence down said swamp to cor. Blowt & Augustus Williams thence down swamp on said Williams' line to poplar cor in branch, thence S 75° E 44.4 ch to Hickory, thence S 75° E 27.4 ch to R.O. S. a. south & of the dead Hickory the commencement containing forty (40) acres more or less being a portion of the Warrent Quarter tract, and bounded on N by Blowt's land on E by Augt. Williams' and on S and W by Richard H. Collings' land. The said Richard H. Collings and H. F. Bradshaw covenant that they have the right to convey the said land to the greater, that they have done no act to dismember the said land, that the grantees shall have quiet possession of the said land, free from all encumbrances, and that the said Richard H.
