Schrell, Grantee of the other part, all of Southampton County Virginia, Witnesses, that for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and seventy five dollars this day paid by the party of the grant our receipt of which is to be acknowledged this day Robert C. Brickett and Rebecca C. Brickett wife of grant and Convey, bargain and sell unto the said Jas. C. Schrell all of their interest in two certain tracts or parcels of Land lying on the River Gules in Drewsville District Southampton County Virginia containing 1654 1/2 acres more or less, and bounded by the lands of A. H. Barham, W. T. Hicks sections it being an undivided interest in the Real Estate formerly belonging to Elizabeth Little deceased and bequeathed in her last will testament to her Son of Margaret C. Brickett her daughter, one of whom is the said Robert C. Brickett who hereby conveys his entire interest under said will to the said James C. Schrell with general warranty, with the following covenations and conditions
