Lewis, with General Warranty, all of their eighth parts and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land, it being a portion of the James Joyner tract, containing two hundred acres more or less bounded as follows, on the north by Black Creek Swamp on the South by Lewis Lewis beginning at a gate post near Lewis Lewis Station and running west the said path to a pine tree in Beech Branch, on the east by Beech Branch leading from Beech Branch to Franklin, on the west by Beech Branch the said Tabitha Lewis & Martha Anne Lewis his wife do warrant that they have the right to convey the said land to the grantee that they have it quiet and to encumber the said land, that the grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land free from all manner of claims, and that Tabitha Lewis and Martha Anne Lewis his wife parties of the first part shall execute such further assurances of the said land as may be requisite.
