 soil and is desirous to obtain during the present year advance-
 ment in supplies from the said David Turner to the amount of
 two hundred dollars, beyond which sum the said Ephraim
 Turner shall not go, and the said David Turner having
 agreed on his part to furnish the said advances, and the
 said Ephraim Turner on his part in consideration of
 the above premises do hereby grant a lien to the said
 David Turner, on the property which may be made during
 the present year upon the land in the cultivation of which
 the said David Turner has been engaged, for the amount of advances
 he has advanced, under an act of the General Assembly
 of Virginia, approved April 2nd 1873, entitled an act
 to secure advances for agricultural purposes. Although the
