

in such manner as he said J. Lewis Gillett or his executors
administrators or assigns shall prescribe and direct or in
case of his death failure to give such direction at such
time and in such manner as the said Trustees or either of
them shall think fit. The said J. Lewis Gillett warrants
to pay all taxes, assessments, dues, and charges upon the
said property hereby conveyed, so long as he or his heirs
or assigns shall hold the same and hereby waives the
benefit of his homestead exemption as to the debt accrued
upon by the debt. If no default shall be made in the
payment of the above mentioned debt, then, upon the
request of the party of the first part a good and
sufficient release shall be executed to him
at his own proper costs and charges.
