Whereas by a deed of the County of York of Greenville, taken at the Sundry Term 1871, in the Chancery suit therein depending, styled Harris v. John v. Thos. B. Pearce & co. appeared a Special Commission to sell the real estate belonging to E. B. Thorp and whereas at the sale thereof Feb'y 16: 1871 Sterling Sledge became the purchaser by bidding therefor the sum of \$1460. For which said sale was set on bid to Court and confirmed, and whereas before the payment for the said land, the said Sterling Sledge departed this life, after having made & published his last will & testament - by which said will he directed that his estate should be kept together during his wife's life or widowhood - and further gave of this tract of land to his daughter Alice Sledge, now Alice Ince, claiming her mother's life and at her death to her issue and if she left none issue, then to Ophelia Sledge, now Ward, during her life & at her death to her issue - and whereas the said land has been fully paid for by the sum with the well amount of the said Sledge, and the parties to whom it is given, it is entitled to a deed for the same. Pearce Com. has duly granted and conveyed with Special Warranty unto the said Alice Ince, the said tract of land containing 20 &c. acres of land, situate lying in Greenville & partly lying in Southampton bounded by the lands of Thos. B. & co. the lands of Sterling Sledge &c. for &c. To have &c. &c. to have &c. the said subject however in all the provisions conditions & trusts imposed upon the same by the last will and testament of the said Sterling Sledge.
