 This Deed of Bargain and Sale from J. H. Griffie to Alice
 Lewis, was this day read and acknowledged by said Alice to
 be his act and deed and admitted to record.

This Deed made this 21st day of October 1878 between K. P. Griffie
 and Alice H. Lewis wife of the County of Southampton and State of
 Virginia of the first part and J. H. Griffie of said County and
 State of the second part. Notarially set for and in consideration
 of the sum of three hundred dollars to them in hand paid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said parties
 of the first part do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the
 said party of the second part all of their right, title and inter-
 est, it being one half an acre to that certain lot of land
 lying in the County and State aforesaid, and in front
 of the Store House of the parish of Ketchum, and bounded on the
 north by the various Church lot, on the South by the lands
 of S. H. Griffie, on the east by the Pauline and Jerusalem
 roads, and on the west by the public road running by
 Matthew Torgner, S. A. Gays and Mrs. M. A. Pennington. Con-
 taining about one acre more or less, together with all of their
 improvements thereon including Saw, Gum, gumming and
 fixtures. It being the same property owned by the said
 K. P. Griffie and Griffie for the purpose of giving in Evidence
 Witness the following signatures and seals the day
 and year above written.
