This Deed made this 1st day of January 1878 between Henry
 C. Moore of the one part and C. S. Story of the other part
 witnesses that the said Henry C. Moore doth grant unto
 the said C. S. Story one tract of land lying in the County
 of Southampton bounded by the lands of Chris Moore, late
 of Williamsport, dec'd Susan F. Perkins and others known as the
 Barnes place, containing one hundred and twenty four
 more or less, being the land upon which said Henry C.
 Moore now resides. The tract to secure, said one bond ex-
 ecuted by said Henry C. Moore to Nancy McBlenny be-
 coming date the 1st day of January 1878 for the payment
 of Ten Dollars and eighty cents on the 1st day of July 1878
 and at the expiration of every six months thereafter, during
