Urquhart of the first part & Samuel Williams of the second part both of Southampton County & State of Virginia, witnesseth, that the said W. H. Urquhart for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to him in hands paid, at or before the making & delivery of these presents receipt whereof is here by acknowledged, hath given, granted, bargained, sold & doth by these presents give, grant, bargain & sell, with general warranty, to the said Samuel Williams, all of a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton & containing sixty acres & more or less as follows: That is to say, beginning at a stone, where the line between W. H. Urquhart & John W. Atkins crosses the road from the "Division Tract" (Mr. W. Urquhart's) to the plank road, thence a more or less easterly course, along the line between said Urquhart & Atkins to a perpendicular corner for Urquhart & Atkins in Mrs. M. Williams' line, thence along the line between Urquhart & Williams, to a corner for Urquhart & John Jones in Mrs. Williams' line, thence along the line between Urquhart & Jones, to a pine on said road, corner for Jones in Urquhart's line, thence along said road to the stone point of starting, to have and to hold the said Samuel Williams & his heirs forever.
