This Deed made this 22nd day of May A.D. 1878 between Alfred Stephenson avou^r de bonis non with the will annexed of Robert G. Millitt dec^d of the first part and Joseph Councille of the second part (per clause at sale) directed by the will of said Robert of a portion of real estate, situate with that in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred and five dollars paid to Jas. G. Jones Executor of said will, the said Alfred S. Stephenson Executor of Jas. G. Jones dec^d and Adm^r de bonis non^r of said will being fully satisfied that the whole of said sum has been paid, do the grant unto the said Joseph Councille with special warranty all that tract of land lying on the South side of the N. W. & O. R. R. and known as the Brown tract, containing three hundred and forty six (346) acres more or less, also bounded as follows to wit: On the north by said Robert and the lands of George Hoon dec^d. On the west by the lands of Solomon Brille. On the South by the lands known as the Hony Land. On the East by the lands of Camp, Johnson Souce Key, Allen Johnson and Dr. J. H.
