His Deed of Bargain and Sale from J.B. Prince & Joseph S. Budd,
to Archer Anderson was this day received and together with
the certificates thereunto annexed to record.

This Deed made this 27th day of November, one thousand
eight hundred, and Sixty eighth between Archer An-
derson and Mary Anne Anderson his wife of the
one part and John A. Cole of the other part, witness-
eth that the said Anderson doth grant with gen-
eral warranty unto the said John A. Cole that certain
tract of land in the County of Southampton known as
Footville containing nine hundred acres being
the same tract of land conveyed to James W. Cobb
by Lewis E. Mason, by deed dated 1st April 1859 and
fully recorded in the Clerks Office of the County Court of
Southampton and conveyed to the said Archer Ander-
son by J.B. Prince and Joseph S. Budd, Commissioners
under Seal of the Circuit Court of Queen's Bench in and
of God's Execution vs Cobb & others by deed dated the
19th day of November 1878. In trust, to remain in the
first place the costs and expenses attending the execution
of the trust hereby created, including the Commission
allowed by law to the trustee, and, in the second place,
the payment of three negotiable notes, of sum total twenty
drawn by the said Archer Anderson, and indorsed by J.A.
Glasgow, and payable at the First National Bank of
Richmond, one at six months for ninety dollars, one at
twelve months for same amount, and one at twelve
months for three thousand dollars, and likewise to receive
any and all notes given to renew the notes above mentioned
in whole or in part. In the event that default shall be made
in the payment of either of the abovementioned notes, or of
any note or note given to renew the same in whole or in part,
as they become due and payable, then the said John A. Cole
on being required so to do by the holder of the note thus de-
nounced shall sell all the property hereby conveyed, at Jerusalem or
at such other place, as the said trustee may deem best for
the interest of all parties, and it is covenanted and agreed be-
tween the parties aforesaid, that in case of a sale, the same
shall be made after first advertising the time place and
terms of sale for ten days in some newspaper published in
the city of Petersburg, and posting notice at the front door
of the Court House of Southampton County on a County
Court day, previous to such sale, and on the following day
to wait for such time as much of the proceeds as may be
necessary to defray the expenses of executing the trust, in-
cluding the trustee's commissions, and to his charge the
amount of money then due upon the said notes, and
