Daughton, all of his right title and interest in and to that certain house and lot, situated in the town of Franklin Virginia, on the East side of main street, and bounded as follows, by a line commencing at the intersection of main street and fourth avenue, thence north along main street 2 1/2 feet thence East along a line parallel with fourth avenue 55 feet, thence south 2 1/2 feet to front Avenue, thence West along said Avenue 55 feet to main street the point of beginning. It being the same lot which the said Councille purchased of Jethro Cobb, but for which - all of the purchase money not being paid. He has no deed, but having paid a part of the purchase money and having built a house on said lot. He the said E. P. Councille hath by these presents bargained, sold and conveyed all of his right title and interest in and to the same unto the D^r. M. E. Daughton, his heirs and assigns forever. In trust, to secure to Joseph P. Webb the payment of one note for the sum of \$49.⁰⁰ Subject to a deed of M. E. Daughton bearing date on the 20th of February 1878, executed by the said Councille and payable to the said Webb three months after date and also to secure to Messrs Darden & Ely the payment of one note for the sum of Two ³⁰100 dollars bearing date on the 21st day of February 1878, executed by the said E. P. Councille, and payable to the said Darden & Ely three months after date. Witness the following signatures and seal the day and year above written.

This Deed made this 29th day of November in the year of our Lord 1878 between John Gorde special Commissioner of the one part and John Pullow of the other part. Whereas on the 20th day of November in the year 1875, it was decreed
