This deed of trust made this 4th day of December
A.D. 1878 between Edward Beaton and Sophia A. Beaton
his wife of the County of Southampton State of Virginia
parties of the first part and Joseph D. Prince the trustee
of the same County and State of the second part -
Witnesseth that for and in consideration of one de-
liver in hand paid to the parties of the first part by the
trustee the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the parties
of the first part doth grant and convey unto the party
of the second part (the trustee) the following real estate lying
8 being in Southampton County, Virginia. That is to say
all that portion of what is commonly known as the
"Sibley tract land" lying south of the St. R.R. - and appear-
to contain about five hundred & fifty acres - and bounded
north by the S. & R.R. east by the lands of J. Gardner
& Wm. H. Beaton, south by the lands of W. W. Whiting
and west by the lands of W. A. Jaynor. The premises being
conveyed as in trust, however to secure the payment
of a note of Eight hundred Dollars - due from W. H. Beaton
& Walter Jones, partners trading under the firm style
of W. H. Beaton & Co. and said note bearing date with
this writing. In testimony whereof the said parties
hereof present do hereunto set their hands & seals the
date first above written -
