 sold to Robt S Pope is absolute and unconditional. In

Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court of  
 Southampton County rendered at the October  
 Term 1878 in the Chancery suit of Borden & Womble  
 it was ordered that J N Sebrell, as special Com-  
 missioner should execute to Jas A. Barber the plain-  
 tiff a Deed for the undivided interest of Faunie  
 Womble in the land mentioned in the proceed-  
 ings and whereas the said Jas A. Barber has  
 this day, to wit the 3<sup>rd</sup> December 1878 paid  
 unto the said J N Sebrell Commissioner after  
 said the sum of One hundred and fifteen  
 dollars together with Twenty seven 6<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> p<sup>c</sup> Dollars  
 the legal costs of said suit the receipt of which  
 said sum is hereby acknowledged, now therefore  
 this Deed Witnesseth that the said J N Sebrell  
 Womble as aforesaid doth grant and convey  
 bargain & sell unto the said James A. Barber  
 with special warranty the tract of land that  
 is to say the undivided interest of Faunie  
 Womble in the land formerly belonging to  
 Abelomimus P Williams deceased containing  
 by estimation 88 acres more or less and bounded  
 by the lands of Jacob Barber died Mrs Mary  
 & Jerry G. W. Brake & others. Witness the further
