B. Cutler the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold to the said G. B. Cutler hereunto in witness that she now has or may have in a tract or parcel of land on which John Harrell died seised and possessed containing 53 1/2 acres more or less and bounded by the lands of G. B. Cutler and Joel Vick and the said Ina Cristabel Whitley wants all her right and title in the above described land in witness whereof she has hereunto set her hand and seal the day and year above written.

Beale his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Clara Beale of the same County and State of Virginia of the second part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the said Clara Beale the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Spikes Beale and wife and James I. Beale and wife do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Clara Beale a certain lot or parcel of land in Southampton County near old South quay known as the South
