Deemed This Deed made this 18th day of December A.D.
 eighteen hundred and seventy eight before
 Thomas J. Pittman Commissioner of the first part
 and Thomas W. Oliver of the second part, both of
 the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, with
 Aug 1878 respect as follows: Whereas the said Pittman
 acting in pursuance of a decree of the Circuit
 Court of said County, rendered at the May term
 A.D. 1878 in the suit of John Pittman junior vs. the
 Lavelle brothers, as Commissioners aforesaid did
 convey to me certain real estate, lying in the
 town of Franklin, in said County; and the
 said Oliver became the purchaser of a certain
