I examined The Deed made this 18th day of December Anno Domini eighteen hundred and seventy-eight between Thomas W. Oliver and Alice L. his wife, of the first part; Thos. J. Pellow, of the second part; and the parties herein after named of the third part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia. Whereas, that the said parties of the first part do hereby grant unto the said party of the second part, with general warranty, all of that certain parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in the town of Franklin, in said County, and supposed to contain about half an acre - more or less, lying the same lot on parcel of land of which was this day granted and conveyed by me to the said Thomas W. Oliver by Thos. J. Pellow my last law commission, with all the buildings standing and appertaining to the said lot in comprising any manner attached or belonging. Whereof the said lot is indicated on the Map of the town of Franklin as lot number 16 sixteen. In trust to secure the payment presentment of the following bonds, to-wit: one bond made payable to Thos. J. Pellow Commissioner in the chancery suit of Mrs. Britton vs. Dr. D. Cobb torture and affge. to said Commissioner to Dr. D. Cobb which said bond is for the principal sum of one hundred & eighty two dollars & fifty cents dated September 19th A.D. 1878 payable ten years after date, but bearing interest from date, also to secure one other bond made payable to the said Commissioner and affge. by him to Thos. J. Pellow &c. which said bond is for the principal sum of one hundred and eighty two dollars & fifty cents, due & payable one year after date, but bearing interest from date. also one other bond made payable to said Commissioner and assigned by him to the said John Pellow &c. for the like sum of one hundred & eighty two dollars & fifty cents due & payable three years after date, but bearing interest from date. - cost of said last named bonds being dated September 19th 1878 - all three of the said bonds are signed by the said Mr. Oliver.
