This Deed made this 18th day of December A.D. 1878 between Dominie Lightner Turner and twenty eight, between Thomas H. Oliver and Miss L. his wife, of the first part; Tho. J. Putlow, of the second part; and the parties herein after named of the third part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia. Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part do hereby grant unto the said party of the second part, with general warranty, all of that certain parcel or lot of land lying and being situate in the town of Franklin, in said County, and supposed to contain about half an acre - more or less

partly, and being the same lot on parcel of land of which was this day granted and conveyed unto the said Thomas H. Oliver by Thomas J. Putlow, and his commissioners, with all the buildings thereon, and appurtenances to the said lot in any manner attached or belonging.

1. Sheweth which said lot is indicated on the Map of the town of Franklin as lot number 16, situate. In trust to secure the pay-

ment pro. rata, of the following bonds to wit: one bond made payable to Tho. J. Putlow & co. Commissioners in the chancery suit of Mrs. Putlow & co.
